Things You'll Need

- Cleaning Cloth/Soft Sponge
- Baking Soda/Lemon Juice
- Vinegar
- Non-abrasive Cleaning Spray like Windex

Never Use

- Steel Wool
- Harsh Abrasive Chemicals

A Good Daily Routine

A quick wipe daily will work wonders. Just wet your basin, spray on a mild surface cleaner like Windex, and give it a quick wipe with a non-abrasive cleaning cloth. Always wipe in the direction of the stainless steel grain to avoid scratches.

For a More In-Depth Clean

1. Give your basin a quick rinse, then sprinkle a generous amount of baking soda over the entire surface of the damp basin.
2. Now gently wipe the paste over basin's surface using the damp sponge or cloth. Make sure to wipe in the direction of the stainless steel grain to avoid scratching. The baking soda and water will form a paste that helps lift away dirt and stains while being gentle on the stainless steel surface.
3. Next up, sprinkle on a generous dose of lemon juice or white vinegar. The juice will react with the residual baking soda to create a fizzing action.
4. Let the reaction work for a few minutes, and then gently rub with a soft cloth or sponge. Rinse thoroughly with water and dry with a clean cloth.
5. To finish up, spray on a mild cleaner like Windex, give it a quick wipe with a non-abrasive cleaning cloth, and buff it up to a shine.
