

Stainless Steel Basin Cleaning Guide

Stainless steel basins bring a sleek, polished look to any bathroom. With a little regular care, they'll stay looking their best. Here's how to give yours the TLC it deserves.

Things You'll Need

- Cleaning Cloth/Soft Sponge
- Baking Soda/Lemon Juice
- Vinegar
- Non-abrasive Cleaning Spray

Never Use

- Steel Wool
- Harsh Abrasive Chemicals

A Good Daily Routine

A quick wipe daily will work wonders. Just wet your basin, spray on a mild surface cleaner, and give it a quick wipe with a non-abrasive cleaning cloth. Always wipe in the direction of the stainless steel grain to avoid scratches.

For a More In-Depth Clean

1. Give your basin a quick rinse, then sprinkle a generous amount of baking soda over the damp surface. Add a splash of water to form a paste.
2. Using a damp sponge or cloth, gently wipe the paste over the basin in the direction of the grain to avoid scratching. The paste lifts away dirt and stains while staying gentle on the stainless steel.
3. Sprinkle on some lemon juice or white vinegar. It'll react with the leftover baking soda and start to fizz. Let this work for a few minutes.
4. Gently rub with a soft cloth or sponge, then rinse thoroughly and dry with a clean cloth.
5. Finish with a light spray of mild surface cleaner, wipe with a non-abrasive cloth, and buff to a shine.
